Missing Piece – Humility

Series Passage: John 10:10 - The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly.

Matthew 20: 25-28 - But Jesus called them together and said, “You know that the rulers in this world lord it over their people, and officials flaunt their authority over those under them. But among you it will be different. Whoever wants to be a leader among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first among you must become your slave. For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve others and to give his life as a ransom for many.”

- 2) Acknowledge where you need to **GROW**.
- 3) **LEARN** from Jesus.
- 4) **SERVE** as Jesus did.

Missing Piece – Humility

- How would you describe humility? Why is it hard to be humble? When was a time you failed at being humble? And when was a time that you were successful at being humble?
- Read Matthew 20:25-28. How does most of the world view power and our rights as humans? How does the world view humility (putting others first)? How does the world view recognition? How is all of this destructive? Or is it? Why does Jesus make humility an issue?
- Read John 17:1-17. Why did Jesus wash His disciples feet? What makes this a humble act? He says go and do likewise... what does this mean? How can you “wash someone’s feet”?
- How does humility make the world go around? What do you want your life to look like? How are you going to do this? What do you want the world to look like – including your neighborhood? How is being humble a key to these two questions?
- What are you willing to do to be humble and grow by taking up your cross?
- Gather into smaller groups and pray for one another.
